## Fitzgerald State School One-to-One BYOD Laptop Program for Year 5 & 6 Students 2026

Dear Parents,

Our school prides itself on preparing students for the digital age. As part of this commitment, all students in Year 5 and Year 6 will participate in a BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) One-to-One Laptop Program in 2026.

This program continues the BYOD initiative currently in place. The BYOD program, as defined by the Department of Education, refers to teaching and learning environments in Queensland State Schools where personally owned mobile devices are used to access the department's information and communication (ICT) network.

At Fitzgerald State School, digital devices refer specifically to laptops to ensure consistency in teaching and learning across our primary setting.

The following information provides an overview and expectations of the program:

- → The laptop must meet the Fitzgerald State School system specifications (attached) before it can be accepted into the program.
- → Apple Mac, Chromebook and other devices listed under "Not Supported" are not compatible and cannot be used at school.
- → Windows laptops are the designated devices, as they are best suited to the curriculum and school software.
- → Laptops older than three years are unlikely to perform adequately on the school network and may disadvantage your child's learning.
- → The BYOD laptop can continue to be used as your child transitions to high school.
- → Laptops currently used by Year 5 students will remain suitable for Year 6 in 2026.

#### Student responsibilities:

Students are responsible for the care, management and troubleshooting of their laptop. Laptops must arrive fully charged each day, and families must provide a protective laptop bag designed for transport. Families are also responsible for arranging insurance / warranty for their child's device.

If you have concerns about the program due to financial hardship, please contact Mrs Tracey Adams, Principal, to discuss possible support options.

All supporting information is available on the school website. A *BYOD Pre-Setup Guide* will be shared later in the year. BYOD Intune enrolment details and passwords will be provided at the start of term 1, 2026.

Enrolment of your student's BYOD laptop to the Fitzgerald State School network will begin at the start of the 2026 school year. This process is scheduled for Term 1 as students are issued new passwords at the beginning of each year.

#### At the beginning of Term 1, 2026 all Year 5 and 6 students will receive:

- → Their EQ username and password
- → Intune BYOD enrolment instructions
- → The 2026 Fitzgerald State School Student Laptop Charter

Fitzgerald State School uses Microsoft Intune, a secure mobile device management system that allows personal devices to safely access school Wi-Fi, email, learning applications, and websites.

There is no cost for students to use Microsoft Intune or Microsoft Office 365. Any additional software required for classroom learning and assessment will be provided and managed by the school.

**Please note:** Antivirus software is not included. It is your responsibility to ensure your child's laptop has up-to-date antivirus protection. Devices without antivirus software will not be permitted to connect to the school network.
